### Mark 16:16

#### According to Jesus:

“He that believeth and is baptized, shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be condemned.”

Now mark which answer you agree with.

1. Question: Who “will be saved” *according to Jesus?*

Answer:

“He that believeth and is baptized, shall be saved.”

or,

“He that believeth shall be saved and then be baptized.”

or,

“He that is baptized, shall be saved, and then believes.”

### James 2:17

“Even so faith, if it hath not works, is dead being alone.”

2. Question:

Can “faith alone” save someone?

Answer: YES NO

### James 2:24

“You see then how that by works a man is justified, and not by faith only.”

3. Question:

Can a man be “justified” by “faith only”?

Answer: YES NO

**James 2:21**

“Was not Abraham our father justified by works, when he offered Isaac his son upon the altar?”

**4. Question:**

Was Abraham justified by faith or by works?

**Answer:**

By works  By faith

**James 2:26**

“For as the body without the spirit is dead, so faith without works is dead also.”

**5. Question:**

Is faith “without works,” dead?

**Answer:** YES NO

**James 2:22**

“You see that faith was active along with his works, and by works faith was made perfect?”

**6. Question:**

Can faith “without works,” be made perfect?

**Answer:** YES NO

**Hebrews 5:9**

“And being made perfect, he became the author of eternal salvation unto all them that obey him.”

**7. Question:**

To whom did Jesus became the author of eternal salvation?

**Answer:**

“Unto all them that obey him”

“Unto all them that have “faith only”

### Matthew 28:19

“Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them *in the name* of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.”

#### 8. Question:

Is baptism in “the name” of the Three Persons, that is, the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit?

Answer: YES NO

#### 9. Question:

Can a person become united with that Name before he is baptized?

Answer: YES NO

### Galatians 3:27

“For as many of you as have been baptized into Christ have put on Christ.”

#### 10. Question:

Can a person “put on Christ” before he or she is baptized?

Answer: YES NO

### Romans 6:4

“Therefore we are buried with him by baptism into death: that like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the father, even so we also should walk in newness of life.”

#### 11. Question:

Can a person “walk in newness of life” before he or she is baptized?

Answer: YES NO

### Romans 6:5

“For if we have been united with him in a death like his, we shall certainly be united with him in a resurrection like his.”

#### 12. Question:

Can a person be “united with Christ” **before** he or she has been baptized?

Answer: YES NO

#### 13. Question:

Is water baptism a **commandment** of the Lord?

Answer: YES NO

Now read John 14:15, 21, 23, 24; Luke 6:46!

#### 14. Question:

Can a person be saved **without obeying** the commandment of the Lord to be baptized?

Answer: YES NO

Please, read again John 14:15, 21, 23, 24; Luke 6:46 and Hebrews 5:9!

### Ephesians 4:5

“One Lord, one faith, one baptism.”

#### 15. Question:

Which is the **one baptism** from these mentioned below:

1. The baptism into Moses (1 Cor. 10:1-2)?

2. The baptism of John (Matt. 3:1-2, 11)?

3. The baptism of suffering (Matt. 20:22-23)?

### **Luke 24:47**

“And that repentance **for the remission of sins** should be preached in his name among all nations, beginning at Jerusalem.

### **16. Question:**

*Are repentance and baptism commanded so that one may receive the remission of his or her sins?*

**Answer:** YES NO

### **Matthew 26:28**

“For this is my blood of the new covenant, which is shed for may **for the remission of sins.**”

17. **Question:**

Was the blood of Christ shed because men had **already** received the remission of their sins **before he died for them on the cross** or to **receive the remission of their sins** by His death on the cross?

**1 Peter 3:21**

“The like figure whereunto even **baptism doth also now save us** (not the putting away of the filth of the flesh, but the answer of a good conscience toward God,) by the resurrection of Jesus Christ.”

18. **Question:**

Do you believe, that according to Peter, inspired by the Holy Spirit, “**baptism doth also now save us**”?

**Answer:** YES NO
